**ACHIEVE THESE OBJECTIVES:**

- ✓ Discuss current epidemiology of STDs and its impact on specific subpopulations, including **women, adolescents, men who have sex with men, persons living with HIV, African Americans and other racial/ethnic groups.**
- ✓ Describe physical presentations, diagnostic approaches, and management strategies for chlamydia, gonorrhea, and related syndromes: **syphilis, genital herpes, human papillomavirus infections, hepatitis A, B, & C, vaginitis, common genital dermatologic conditions.**
- ✓ Become more familiar with female pelvic & male genital exam techniques through **hands-on practice.**
- ✓ Describe quality control and infection control issues relevant to performing **wet preparations** of vaginal specimens.

The **FUNDAMENTALS OF STDs IN CLINICAL PRACTICE** is an intensive 3-day training for clinicians desiring in-depth, comprehensive training in sexually transmitted diseases. STDs commonly seen in clinical practice and issues relevant to diagnosis and treatment are addressed by local and national experts. Course fee: \$225. (21.25 CME credits: \$90 | 25.5 Nursing Contact Hours: free)

The optional **MALE & FEMALE GENITAL EXAM SKILLS PRACTICUM** is designed for clinicians who will be using these skills in their clinical practice. This hands-on, skills-based 4-hour training focuses on the male and female genital exam. All participants will have the opportunity to practice on model male and female teaching assistants. Recommended for clinicians interested in improving exam skills. Course fee: \$75. (4 CME credits: \$15 | 4.8 Nursing Contact Hours: free) 8:00 a.m.-12 noon

The optional **EXAM & INTERPRETATION OF VAGINAL WET MOUNTS** is 3-hour training on applicable issues of CLIA regulation, quality & infection control, interpretations of vaginal wet mounts (VWM) & application to diagnosis of vaginitis. This is an experiential (“hands-on”) training, with substantial time spent as a lab practicum on examination of saline & KOH VWM. Participants will have ample opportunity for practice, 1:1 with instructors, and return demonstrations. Contact us for more information. Course fee: \$75.
