ACHIEVE THESE OBJECTIVES:

- ✓ Describe epidemiology, physical presentation, diagnostic, counseling, and management strategies of **Chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, HPV, HSV, and vaginitis.**
- ✓ Identify the relationship between **STD infection and HIV transmission.**
- ✓ Identify key patient information to be obtained in a **sexual history** and give examples of open-ended questions to use to obtain this information.
- ✓ Describe clinical presentation and diagnosis of **sexually transmitted hepatitis and enteritis.**
- ✓ Identify the steps in appropriate order for conducting complete routine **female & male genital examination.**

STD OVERVIEW FOR CLINICIANS covers epidemiology, diagnosis, treatment, and management of STDs for the practicing clinician. Includes sexual history-taking & client-centered counseling. The optional **MALE & FEMALE GENITAL EXAM SKILLS PRACTICUM** is designed for clinicians who will be using these skills in their clinical practice. This hands-on, skills-based 4-hour training focuses on the male and female genital exam. All participants will have the opportunity to practice on model male and female teaching assistants. Recommended for clinicians interested in improving exam skills. Prerequisite: STD Overview for Clinicians or other approved course. 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. Course fee: \$75; (4 CME credits; \$15 | 4.2 Nursing Contact Hours: free)
