

Medical History: Open-ended Questions

Transitional Statement: "I'm now going to ask you some questions about your medical history which will give us a better understanding of your overall health and can tell us what support services might be useful to you."

- What was your sex at birth?
- What gender are you now?
- When and where was the last time you had a blood test? What provider
- When and where did you last donate blood?
- When was the last time you were treated for a sexually transmitted infection? Which STI?
- What other sexually transmitted diseases have you had?
- When was your last HIV test and what were the test results?
- What type of HIV care are you receiving? Tell me about the testing and anti-retroviral drugs regimen?
- What other prescription drugs are you taking now? Birth control? Antibiotics in the past year?
- In thinking about the symptoms that xx can cause, what type of symptoms have you noticed? When did you first notice them? What type of sex do you have?
- When was your last period? When was the last time you were pregnant? What are the chances that you are pregnant now? Where are you receiving prenatal care?
- When was the last time you were in a hospital/ rehab/ mental health or other institution?
